5:1 This *is* the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him;

Zeh seypher toledot 'adam beyom This (is) book of generations of mankind in the day

bero' 'elohiym 'adam bidemut 'elohiym that created God mankind in the likeness of God

'asah 'oto. made he him.

sepher, saphar: 720, ₹

- to support the mouth of a person, to sum or gather up into one, to tally or number, to disseminate in words.
- not limited to a book as we know it.

Two possibilities:

- a. Adam was much more advanced than we have been taught (Cain's descendants were inventors of) or
- b. there is no reference to an actual book but rather this is 'how it went down' so to speak and was later gathered unto a book by Moses.
