סנא/שנא

From shen – tooth – used by animals to tear away at their prey - to change/exchange as to separate one's self. Also samech/nun as in a seed that produces thorns – thorn bush – distance one's self.

Nicolaitans

One who follows Nikolaos

from - nikolaos

nike* – Greek goddess of victory

laos – the people

*Nike shoes – winged goddess

Possibly equivalent to Baalim (lord over the people)

- Cp Miz 18:27, Luke 1:52, (*hubristos, hubris*) Romans 1:30, 2 Cor12:10 (relate to tares Obad 3) – pin heads – 1 Tim 1:13 – Paul was once this cp Tarsus.
- Talk about ga’on or pride Miz 59:12
- Contrast humble in Torah – Dvar 8:2
- Result is Mishlei 16:18

Lashon Shaqer - tongue

- Lying tongue – deliberately deceive
(associated with eyes – Yesha 3:16) Miz
109:2; 120:2, Mish 12:19,22; 14:5; 20:17,
Luke 18:11, Yoch 8:44, Hit 22:11:15, (adikeo)
- Contrast lying in Torah – Vay 19:11
- Cognate – shakar – drunk – something other
than yourself.

Hands shedding innocent blood hands pouring out innocent blood - hands

- *v^eyadayim shoph^ekot dam-naqiy* – Deut 19:10; 27:25, 2 Kings 24:4, Miz 106:38, Mishlei 1:16-18, Yesha 59:7, Yirm 26:15
- ABORTION! – Dvar 1:39 little ones – taphaph Yeshe 3:16 – not able to walk out their lives yet – naqiy (נָקִי, dikaios) – 1st – Bere 20:5, 24:41 – Bere 6:9 – tzaddiq, Mt 1:19, Rom 1:17
- Shedding (shaphak, ekcheo)– 1st – Bere 9:6 – bowls of wrath in Hitgalut
- Contrast ratzach in Torah Sh^emot 20:13

Heart devises wicked thoughts - heart

- *Lev choresh mach^esh^evot 'aven* – Charash – to plow into (physical and spiritual, something deliberate), 1st - Bere 4:22, plow, be silent, hold peace, craftsman (to deliberately work something) - tektaino (tectonics, earth filled with violence, Yesha 24) to plan to fabricate, construct, Miz 129:3, MT 13:55
- Contrast in Torah – Dvar 15:9, 19:19

Chashav – to weave or design a pattern - 1st Gen 6:5 computers? Blogs, tweeting, anonymous emails? Spend some time on this one, Miz 10:2, 36:4, Mishle 24:8, Yirm 4:14, Mikhah 2:1 (right out in the open) – different Greek word here than in Gen 6:5 – logismos, 2 Cor 10:5 (word (logos) of God vs word of enmity)

Feet running swift to mischief -feet

- Rag^elayim m^emah^arot larutz lara'ah – Yesha 59:7, Romans 3:10-18 – feet running quickly to evil
- contrast to Torah – Sh^emot 23:2

False witness speaking lies – breath – deep within

- *Yaphiyach k^ezaviym 'ed shaqer* – lying mentioned twice – 1st - Sh^emot 20:16, Dvar 19:16-18, - *psuede martus* - witnesses against Paul – cp Acts 6:13
- Kazav – to say and not do – Bmid 23:19 *adikia* - Yesha 58:11, Mishlei 14:5, 19:5 – Mal 2:6 – Yoch 7:18, Romans 1:18, James 3:6

Sowing discord among brethren - arm

- Um^eshal-leyach m^edaniym beyn achiym – and send forth strife between the brothers - like the two Biblical calendars the seven is the same as the one
- Madan – diyn/'adon – (krisis) to cause to judge on another
- Accuser of the brethren 2 Tim 3:3, Rev 12:10, 1 Pet 3:16, accused is always negative
- Spend the most time on this one.
- Contrast in Torah – Sh^emot 29:2, Vay 19:15

“My latest teaching will blow

“The most spectacular

“The soul source of everything

- All who accept Yeshua as Messiah are indeed one of the 12 lost tribes
- Yeshua is not God/God in the flesh
- It is incumbent upon Christians to take upon a Jewish lifestyle?

Fruit of the Spirit

Galatians 5:22-26

- “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. Longsuffering – *makrothumia* - '*orek 'aph* – Shemot 34:6, Bmid 14:18, Mishlei 19:11, 25:15,

- Gentleness – *chrestotes* - *tov* – Bmid 10:29, Miz 119:39,68
- Goodness – *agathosune* - *yataw* – well – Dvar 4:40, 125:4
- Faith – *pistis* - 'emunah – Dvar 32:20, Hav 2:4
- Meekness – *praotes* - 'anav/'anah – Bmid 12:3, Miz 22:27 – afflict oneself – Yesha 61:1
- Self-control – *engkrateia* – 'aphaq – Bere 43:31, Yesha 42:14

- Pure – tahor - clean – Miz 12:6, 19:9,
- Lovely –proshileys - nashaq/'ahav – affectionate - Mishlei 8:17, Miz 119:47-48,113
- Good report – euphemus - shemu'ah tov– Mishlei 15:30,

Occupy till I come

shall I spend my time pouring over charts and graphs, numbers dates and figures. Writing blogs about the dangers of this or that ministry or this and that teaching, exposing the darkness of this world. Or would I be occupying by clothing the naked, feeding the hungry, visiting and praying for the sick, being fruitful in everything I set my hand to do and living His life in me to the fullest every day. Speaking humble words to my wife and my friends. being gentle and gracious, full of mercy and finally thinking only of those things which are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, and of a good report. I speak to many of our messianic brethren when I say to you. Is your consistent condemnation and hateful words to your brethren a testimony of Yeshua? Is that kind of walk His walk? My God what are we doing to each other?

- When WE hate these seven things, when WE focus on the weightier matters, then I believe God will reveal how to correctly pronounce His name and untangle all the calendar issues. But until we hate what he hates and we love what he loves we will continue to tread water in an endless sea of information. Our trust and faith may not always know where He is leading us but it will always know who is leading us.

Talk about this in the end

- Only a few things our Father HATES – When you hate these things, then I will hear from heaven and heal your land – 2 Chron 7:14 Is Mt 24:7 just talking about pagan nations and kingdoms? Are we not a nation of His people? Are we not in His kingdom?
- Ref main prophetic passages preceded by exhortation to be loving and kind to each other. Ex 1 Thess 4, Mt 24, Rev 2 & 3, Daniel 9:1-23 – finish with each word in the fruit of the spirit.

Mishlei 6:20

“My son, keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother:”

This passage implies that the Torah teaches that our Father loves a humble look, tongue that speaks truth hands that preserve the life of the innocent, a heart that thinks on what is good, feet that run swiftly to heal and deliver, a true and faithful witness that teaches truth and those who sow peace and harmony among the brethren
